Captain Christine L. G. Sears earned her Bachelor of Arts in Biomedical Engineering from The Johns Hopkins University in 1989 and her Medical Doctorate from Northwestern University Medical School in 1993. She was commissioned through the Health Professions Scholarship Program. Captain Sears reported to U.S. Southern Command in June 2021 and currently serves as Command Surgeon.

She completed a surgical internship at Naval Medical Center San Diego, Urology Residency at Naval Medical Center San Diego, and Fellowship in Female Pelvic and Reconstructive Surgery at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. She is a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives and is board certified in Urology.
